Mil Holton, one of the newest saxophonists on the jazz scene has forged his place in the music world with his debut cd titled "Always". Holton was born in Buffalo and educated in Buffalo Public Schools. He is a graduate of Vila Maria College. Holton has recorded to date 2 of his own projects (cds) as well as recorded with the international choir "The New Beginnings Chorale Ensemble". Cementing his reputation of being a smooth savvy musician, he made a decision to crossover to jazz by working with such notables as longtime friend "2x Grammy Nominee & Pioneer of Smooth Jazz" – Najee, American Idol Winner-Ruben Studdard, "Grammy Award Winning Singer"-India Arie and formerly with Incognito-Maysa Leak.

He has also shared the stage with "guitar virtuoso"-Stanley Jordan, Keyshia Cole, Carl Thomas, "Hands of Soul"-Joseph Wooten, Ryan Leslie, Dwele and as of latest "Jazz Legend"-Roy Ayers just to name a few.

He also toured with "The UniverSouls Circus" in 2004. One of the momentous occasions for Will was being awarded the Buffalo Music Award as New Original 1st year artist.

Holton is the founder and president of Brandbuilderz and SSP Events and has made his international writer and publisher debut as he has written the song "Love You A Lifetime" for 2x Grammy Nominee Najee on his new album "Mind Over Matter" from Heads Up Records which also features Eric Benet and Jeff Lorber and is currently working as a co-producer on Najee's 2012 project.

Being released in winter of 2011 will be Will Holton's sophomore album entitled "Deuce" featuring "Neo-Soul King" Jazz vibraphonist-Roy Ayers and longtime friend "pioneer of smooth jazz" Najee, "Rythhm and Soul Diva"-Tifani &Vocalist Roc (the writer) whom has written songs for artist such as Slim from 112, and Angie Stone.

Holton was honored with a call from Steve Quirk the voice of jazzfm.com "fusion flavours radio show" which is based in the United Kingdom to be a part of "fushion flavours 20th anniversary" compilation cd. Holton & Vocalist Jonathan Reed's rendition of "Just the Two of Us" (an R&B Classic by Bill Withers & Grover Washington Jr.) was received very well internationally as was the track that was chosen.

Holton said "I was thrilled to be a part of this compilation and to share the cd with notable giants in the industry such as Kirk Whalum, Fourplay, Euge Groove & Rick Braun."

Holton has been noted as a humanitarian working with many prestigious organizations such as the American Cancer Society, The Patty Perete foundation and March of Dimes. His varied career includes performances for auspicious sororities such as; Alpha Kappa Alpha, Zeta Phi Beta and Delta Sigma Theta.

He has been a continuous supporter and mentor to various Buffalo Public, Charter and surrounding area schools within Western New York including Harvey Austin as a musician & speaker as well as The Global Concept Charter School located in Lackawana. For the past three years Holton has enjoyed his role as one of the Charter schools Story Readers for their Annual Black History Month Celebration.

Holton's "Living the Dream" Experience is attributed to his many accomplishments. embodies Holton's message to youth.... "Despite the obstacles that may present themselves on the road to success... perseverance, dedication and commitment are key. Take the little successes to reach your desired result and become a big success".

Saxophonist Will Holton—born and bred here in Buffalo, recipient of a Buffalo Music Award as best new artist when he was just out of high school, and now a veteran of performances with the likes of Stanley Jordan, Indi. Arie and Keysha Cole—has been making a name for himself in New York City over the past few years. Hooking up with friend and mentor Nojee— iconic sax man and purveyor of what is commonly referred to, for better or worse, as "smooth jazz" —Holton has taken on new dufies as a promotions man, working with Najee to raise the man's profile through social networking sites and the like. Eager to blend his stellar musicianship with a 21st century "do it yourself if you want it done right" work ethic.

Holton is also a rather tireless promoter of the Buffalo music scene. He'll have his chance to many all of these interests together at 7 p. m. Saturday, as he brings Najee to the Traff Music Hall (622 Main St.). This is not your average gig: Najee will be recording his first-ever live album for CD and DVD release at the Traff, where he will be joined by Holton, Alex Bugnon and others for a show blending soul, R&B and jazz—one that's sure to boast plenty of sax firepower. Will Holton played the saxophone on the side while his resume was filling up nicely with his management positions at local printing companies and he dreamed of being a technician for printing giant Xerox. But in 2007 he wandered far off that relatively safe career track for an unpredictable one in music.

And he's transformed his hobby into a multifaceted operation, performing at two packed shows a year at Traff Music Hall and providing music production, song-writing and marketing services to legendary jazz artists Najee and Roy Ayers. His new company, Brand Builderz.com, will broaden those services, extending them to other artists.

Will Holton has played his saxophone as the opening act for national recording artists Jon B., Keyshia Cole, Ryan Lesfe and others. He has organized a concert at the Traif on Sept. 25 featuring Najee.

"A lot of good things are happening." the 30-year-old Buffalo resident said. "It's taken time to get to this point, but these are just confirmations that I've made the right decision and I'm doing the right thing."
